

# You may be eligible to receive \$50/month off your internet bill!

The **Emergency Broadband Benefit (EBB)** is a new federal program that provides eligible households a direct payment of up to \$50 per month toward their internet bill, and a one-time discount of up to \$100 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet.

## It's quick and easy!

### Step 1: Check your eligibility status

A household is eligible for EBB if at least one person in the household is a student in NYC public schools!

Other qualifications for EBB include...

- Income-based federal benefits like SNAP, SSI, federal public housing assistance, or Medicaid;
- The federal Pell Grant program for the current school year; or
- A substantial loss of income due to job loss or furlough since February 29, 2020
