
2018 NYC 3-K PROGRAM LIST | DISTRICT 23

February 5, 2018

3-K for All brings free, full-day, high-quality education to three-year-old children in New York City. 3-K programs lay a strong foundation for children to grow, learn, and explore the world around them.

This fall, we will offer 3-K programs in the following districts, with the goal to bring 3-K for All to every school district in New York City.

- District 4 (East Harlem)
- District 5 (Harlem): Programs will be added in mid-April.
- District 7 (South Bronx)
- District 16 (Bedford-Stuyvesant): Programs will be added in mid-April.
- District 23 (Brownsville, East New York, Ocean Hill)
- District 27 (Broad Channel, Howard Beach, Ozone Park, Rockaways)



3-K information is being updated regularly. Check 3-K Finder at maps.nyc.gov/3k for the most up-to-date 3-K program listings, including more information about 3-K for All in Districts 5 and 16.

Who Can Apply?

New York City families with children born in 2015 are eligible to apply now for 3-K programs that start in the fall of 2018. If your child lives in a school district that has 3-K for All, they will have priority to attend some 3-K programs in their district, but every family in New York City is welcome to apply.

Find 3-K Programs

Families can choose from three types of settings for 3-K programs.

- **District schools.** Some public elementary schools offer 3-K programs.
- **Pre-K Centers.** Some Pre-K Centers offer 3-K in addition to pre-K. Unlike district schools, Pre-K Centers only offer grades before kindergarten.
- **NYC Early Education Centers (NYCEECs).** Some community-based organizations contract with the DOE or the Administration for Children's Services to provide 3-K.

Apply to 3-K Programs

Submit your application between **February 5** and **May 11**. You can apply one of three ways:

- Online at schools.nyc.gov/ApplyOnline
- By phone at **718-935-2009**
- In person at a Family Welcome Center—visit schools.nyc.gov/WelcomeCenters for locations and hours

3-K Admissions is not first come, first served, and you can update your application any time before the May 11 deadline. All families who submit an application by the deadline will get their results letter in late May 2018. If you get an offer, pre-register by the deadline in June 2018 to accept.

3-K FOR ALL: ADMISSIONS PRIORITIES

When there is not enough space at a program for all students who apply, offers are made based on admissions priorities. Admissions priorities are different for each 3-K program type. Below are the admissions priorities for district schools, NYCEECs, and Pre-K Centers.



This is the District 23 program list. District schools in other districts offering 3-K programs may have different admissions priorities—view the 3-K program lists for other districts at nyc.gov/3K.

Admissions Priorities for District Schools in District 23

3-K programs at district schools in District 23 make offers to students in the following order:

1. Students who live in District 23 who will have a sibling at the school
2. Students who live outside District 23 who will have a sibling at the school
3. Students who live in District 23 who won't have a sibling at the school
4. Students who live outside District 23 who won't have a sibling at the school



District 23 is a choice district. This means there are no zoned schools, and children living in District 23 have priority to attend all district school 3-K programs in District 23.

Admissions Priorities for New York City Early Education Centers (NYCEECs)

3-K programs at NYCEECs make offers to students in the following order:

1. Current students enrolled at the NYCEEC
 2. Siblings of current students enrolled at the NYCEEC
 3. Students whose families currently receive free or subsidized social services from the organization running the NYCEEC 3-K program
 4. Students who speak a language other than English that the NYCEEC specializes in serving
 5. All other students living in the district
 6. All other students living outside the district
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NYCEECs with Additional Eligibility Requirements

3-K programs at NYCEECs with additional eligibility requirements make offers to students in the following order:

1. Current students enrolled at the NYCEEC
2. Siblings of current students enrolled at the NYCEEC
3. Students whose families receive free or subsidized social services from the organization running the NYCEEC 3-K program
4. All other students



Some NYCEEC programs have eligibility criteria related to household income, address of residence, government services received, and/or childcare needs. Use 3-K Finder or the entries in this program list to learn which NYCEECs have additional eligibility requirements—programs that do will include a note. Please contact these programs directly before completing your application to find out about additional eligibility requirements.

Pre-K Centers

Pre-K Centers that offer 3-K programs make 3-K offers to students in the following order:

1. Students who live in the district who will have a sibling in pre-K at the Pre-K Center for the 2018-2019 school year
 2. Students who live outside the district who will have a sibling in pre-K at the Pre-K Center for the 2018-2019 school year
 3. Students who live in the same district as the Pre-K Center who won't have a sibling at the center
 4. Students who live outside the district who won't have a sibling at the center
