

DON'T AGREE WITH MY CHILD'S IEP... WHAT DO I DO?

CONTACT YOUR CHILD'S SCHOOL SPECIAL EDUCATION TEAM

• Your first step is to inform your child's school that you disagree with your child's IEP. They can help you try to resolve the issue by amending your child's IEP, reconvening the IEP Team, or holding a re-evaluation meeting.

CONTACT YOUR DISTRICT OFFICE OR CSE

You can try to resolve your issue directly with your District's
 Administrator of Special Education (for public school students) or
 Committee on Special Education (for Pre-K, Charter and Private
 School students; students receiving home-based instruction and
 students awaiting placement).

REQUEST MEDIATION

 You can request mediation through a neutral third-party mediator by emailing your request, including your issue and proposed resolution, to IHOQuest@schools.nyc.gov. Mediation is free and confidential.

REQUEST AN IMPARTIAL HEARING

If your attempts to resolve your concerns are unsuccessful, you
can request a hearing with an Impartial Hearing Officer, who
will step in to determine how your child's educational needs
will be met.
